- Kidson Energy and our suppliers will develop local and indigenous content plans and targets for work scopes managed by Kidson Energy and report against the targets, with a view for continuous improvement.
- Kidson Energy and our suppliers will consider local capabilities during development of procurement strategies, and contract work scopes, to enhance local content.
- Kidson Energy will consider its own, and our suppliers' actions, and incorporate social impact into risk assessments, when considering impact on employees, contractors, suppliers and the wider communities and stakeholders.
